There's no address, but we have two options on how to get to James' Farm:

Turn up Lahainaluna towards the high school. Turn RIGHT onto the bypass. On the LEFT, less than 1/2 mile later, there is a guardrail and if you're going slow enough, you'll see the farm flag (it's red and yellow) and you'll also see some bright green in an otherwise dry area). James recommends pulling onto the shoulder on the mountain side so that you will not have to cross the street to access his farm. Ian will be standing there in his big straw hat. Your children will be escorted one at a time onto the farm, which is set back a safe distance from the road (about 100 yards, with terrain, farmland, and fencing) and will not leave the farm until you're there walking them back to your car.

We understand that not all of you may be comfortable with this drop-off. There is another way to access this farm - just leave yourselves a few extra minutes and be ready for a car wash after - when you're driving up Lahainaluna, 30 feet after the bypass, there will be a small turnout and a yellow gate on your RIGHT, it's set back about 30 feet, too. There is a narrow, one lane dirt road that will take you parallel to the bypass, all the way to the farm. We'll have people with AVT signs pointing the way in case it's not super clear.
